

# Are you paying too much for energy at your hospitality facilities?

## Many hospitality facilities have equipment & systems that are wasting energy and money

Rising energy costs compound the problem. That is why planning, purchasing and installing energy-efficient equipment and systems is more important than ever.

## PSE's rebates for the hospitality industry can help

Qualifying equipment uses much less energy and is eligible for rebates from Puget Sound Energy (PSE.) All equipment must be installed in PSE service territory.

## High-efficiency packaged terminal heat pumps – rebate of \$150

Qualifying Packaged Terminal Heat Pumps (PTHP) are eligible for a rebate if they exceed the current Washington State Energy Code by a minimum of 10 percent and replace an existing Packaged Terminal Air Conditioner or PTHP unit.

## HVAC occupancy controls – rebate of \$75

PSE hospitality electric customers who purchase qualifying HVAC controls are eligible for a rebate of \$75. HVAC occupancy controls must be stand-alone and have automatic unoccupied setback capabilities or a networked guestroom control with similar capabilities. Unoccupied set points must be a minimum of 8 degrees F from the occupied set point. Additionally, the existing HVAC system must be all electric PTAC, PTHP or fan coil systems with electric strip heat.

## Restroom lighting controls – rebate of \$10

PSE hospitality electric customers who purchase qualifying occupancy controls for guest room restroom lighting with a minimum connected load of 50W are eligible for this rebate. Any occupancy-based lighting controls with integrated nightlight are eligible.
